DanceSport Australia Statement on Qualification Process for Olympic Games

The Oceania Qualifying process to determine the two Oceania quota places for Paris 2024 was conducted entirely within World DanceSport Federation (WDSF) rules approved by the IOC using independent international judges.

International judges were flown into Australia to judge contestants in the Oceania Qualifying event held in Sydney in 2023.

“The judging process complied with the required rules for Olympic Games qualification, most importantly that the judging was fair and independent.

No judge had any connection with the competitors who came from multiple countries.

“Significantly, given the misinformation currently in the public domain, it is important to note that neither of the successful competitors has any connection with the administration of the sport beyond being a competing athlete.

No result was challenged by any other competitor or other person.
