ELIGIBILITY, REGISTRATION & LICENSING

- ◆ All competitors must hold current DSA registration.
- ◆ A current WDSF Athlete licence is required for WDSF events.
- ◆ International athletes may dance open events only as per DSA rules.
- ◆ All eligible age groups can dance Open events

PARTNERSHIPS & TEAMS

- ◆ Coaches & professionals may each partner up to two students (Coach/Student and Pro/Student events, counted separately).
- ◆ Synchro teams qualify as groups of three or more competitors.

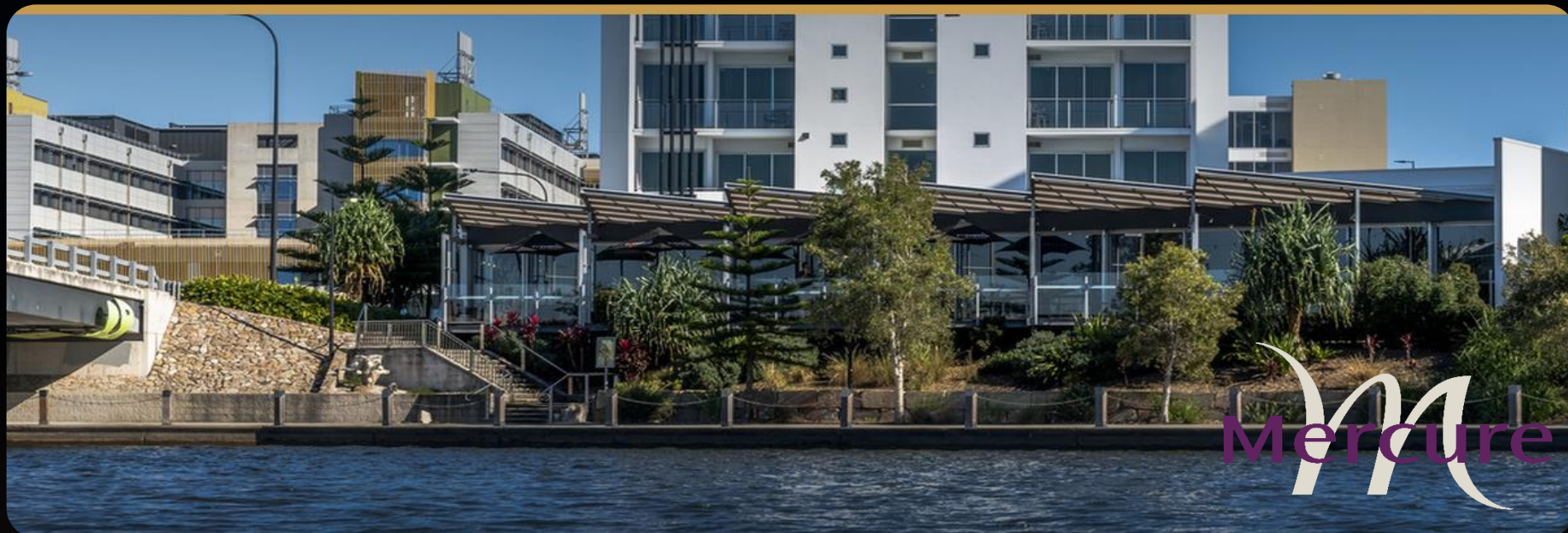

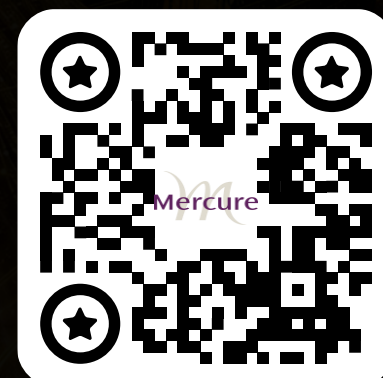
