Conditions of Entry & Important Information

- This event is registered with and conducted under the rules of DanceSport Australia.
- The organizers reserve the right to refuse an entry and combine or cancel an event with insufficient entries.
- Organizers take no responsibility for articles lost or stolen at this event. A cloakroom facility will operate throughout the day.
- The University of NSW is a non-smoking campus. No smoking within the campus, including the Roundhouse venue, is permitted. Campus security personnel reserve the right to remove you from the campus in the event you are caught smoking.

Entry Information

- Entries are via entry.dancesport.org.au
- Entries open on 8 May and close on 30 August.
- Late entries will be accepted up until 6 September subject to a \$20 late fee.
- Entries are only complete once the competitor entry fee is paid. A back number will then be allocated.
- Competitors do not purchase a ticket for this event, your competitor entry fee and back number provides you door entry access to the event via a competitor designated entry point at the venue.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Early bird entry fees are available up until 30 June:

Adult:	\$35
Child (under 16):	\$20
- Entries 1 July – 30 August:

Adult:	\$40
Child (under 16):	\$25

Competitor Information

- Amateur division couples may dance their own grade and open. Open is for grades A, B and C.
- Masters 3 competitors may also dance in Masters 2 Grades/Open.
- Under 21 Open competitors may dance in Adult Open.
- Prize Money is offered for all Adult Open Registered and Professional Open Standard, New Vogue and Latin American events: 1st: \$500; 2nd: \$300 and 3rd \$200.
- A refundable \$5 deposit is required to obtain back numbers.
- Product sponsorship is offered for selected events across registered and recreational divisions. These products are not exchangeable for cash and may not be exchanged for an alternative product.
- First round times will be posted online approximately one week before the event.
- Heel caps must be worn.
- It is a condition of hire that spray tans and tanning products may not be applied within the venue. If you are found to be in breach, a cleaning fee may be levied.

Recreational Events

- Individual competitors may be partnered by any person registered in the Amateur or Recreational Division who does not hold a DSA accreditation.

Pro/Am Events

- Amateur Competitors are restricted to their chosen age division.
- Professionals may dance with one partner per event.

Teacher/Student Events

- A teacher is any registered DanceSport member who holds an accreditation.
- The student must wear the back number as only they will be assessed by the Adjudicators.
- Teachers may dance with one partner per event.

Spectator Tickets

- Spectators purchase tickets via entry.dancesport.org.au
- You must use a valid email as you will receive details regarding your tickets once your payment has been processed.
- Spectator tickets are sold on a non-refundable basis.
- All seating is general admission and unreserved.
- Early bird tickets are available up until 30 June:

Adult: \$35

Aged Concession: \$25

Child (under 16): \$20

- Tickets purchased from 1 July and at the door:

Adult: \$40

Aged Concession: \$30

Child (under 16): \$25

Food & Beverage

- No alcohol will be served within the Roundhouse and is not permitted at this event.
- The Thirsty Burger at the Roundhouse will be open during the event. Food and non-alcoholic beverages may be purchased.
- A limited number of outlets within the UNSW Quad Food Court will be open for service. The Quad Food Court is approximately 4 mins walk from the Roundhouse.
- You may bring your own food and non-alcoholic beverages to the venue.
- All food must be consumed within the designated seating area.
